SCREENING EXAMINATION IN DAK LAK PROVINCE



On April 15, 2023, CVCF, in collaboration with Duc Tam Children's Hospital, Dak Lak Young Physicians Association, and Dak Lak Charity Association, implemented the programme called "Ket Noi Yeu Thuong" (roughly translated as "Love Connection") with the goal of screening and treating a large number of less fortunate people in Dak Lak province.

THE MIRACLE OF LOVE


The Miracle of Love concert, organized in collaboration with saxophonist Tran Manh Tuan, was held on November 25, 2023.






MEDICAL TREATMENT

In 2023, the CVCF examines and treats **123 pediatric patients** with a total medical treatment of **4,509,401,754 VND**, accounting for 87% of total donations. Focus on disease categories, including: Neurosurgery, Eye defects, ROP, Orthopedic injuries, Vascular malformations, Limb defects, Heart disease, Cleft lip - cleft palate and other diseases.




